NO fresh cream or raw eggs should be used as there is no refrigerated access in this area.

Eggs are fine cooked within a cake.

Make sure you clearly label the ingredients in your baking goodies so people are fully aware what is in the product.

All food must be wrapped or covered.

Label your carry container with your name and contact details, so it can be returned to you after the cake sale.

Your cake label must be clearly written and presented with your cake.
